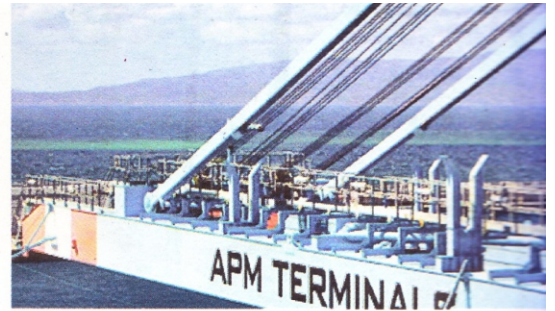
In 2014 the International Women's Leadership Forum awarded her "Leading Woman in Shipping Business".

The International Maritime Organization (IMO) Secretary General Mr. Kitack Lim has appointed Sanjam Sahi Gupta as Member of the World Maritime University's Executive Board for a two-year term. In her new role she will be actively participating in helping shape the future of the University. She is the only Indian lady on the board.

Environmental issues stall the development Of Dahanu port project in Maharashtra

The country's largest container port JNPT is facing hurdles for its most ambitious expansion at Wadhavan, as a local environment authority has stalled the Rs 10,000-crore project. The Dahanu Taluka Environment Protection Authority has objected to the Wadhavan port project, since it felt it would pose a serious threat to the environment.

The local environment authority has turned down the project even when it is constructed in mid sea since the Konkan region where the project is to be set up comes under the fragile environment condition. Our sanction is required even if you construct the project in mid sea as there is considerable opposition from the local population on environmental grounds.

JNPT authorities are in touch with Shipping Ministry, which in turn will have to make

a representation to the Union Environment Ministry. Sources said the central government will be able to prevail on the issue since the Dahanu port construction is a pet project of the Shipping minister Nitin Gadkari.

Dahanu tehsil in the newly carved out Palghar district is in the ecologically sensitive zone and the taluka's green body was set up specifically to protect the area.

In April, JNPT had said it was confident of getting the green nod in three months,

but has received the stop notice "recently".

When asked about how much time it will take to get permission, the port spokesman conceded that this was the project, but was not clear if that such an eventuality had already been factored in.

The setback has come at a critical time, as the port was set to complete its detailed project report and proposed port, which would have an equity contribution from Maharashtra Maritime Board. "The Dahanu environment
